St George's Meet at Deben Swimming Pool, Woodbridge.

Date	23 April 2017
Venue	Deben Swimming Pool, Woodbridge. The pool length is 25m, six lanes, equipped with electronic timing and anti-wave lane ropes.
Age Groups	As at 31 st December 2017. Age groups 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and over 15.
Cost	The Entry Fee is £4.00 per event. Details of accepted/rejected swimmers will be posted on the club website. No details will be sent by post. Please check the posted details on our web site and notify us of any corrections.
Acceptances	This is a first come, first served meet. Entries must be not faster than the cut-off times. 'No time' swims are permitted. Electronic entries are preferred. Entry file set for HYTEK Team Manager is available from www.debenswimmingclub.co.uk . Electronic entries should be submitted to the promoter by the closing date with details of payment at debensc.vicechair@hotmail.co.uk All other entries must be on the official entry form (photocopies and electronic entries accepted), and MUST include the entrants ASA registration number together with all entry fees. Paper entries will incur an admin fee of £1 per swimmer. No entries will be accepted after the closing date or during the meet unless due to promoter's error or omission. Cheques payable to DEBEN SWIMMING CLUB. Closing dates for entries is 31 st March 2017. No refunds after closing date.
Events	All events will be Heat Declared Winners and consist of:- 50m, 100m & 200m Freestyle and Backstroke; 50m & 100m Breaststroke and Butterfly; 100m & 200m Individual Medley. Heats will be swum with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry times.
Awards	Awards will be given to the top three placed swimmers in listed age groups in each individual event as detailed in the qualifying times.

Starts	Over the top starts will be used at the promoter's discretion.
Data Protection	Entries will be managed using meet software, and by entering the meet it will be deemed that all swimmers have given consent, as required by the Data Protection Act, to the holding and distribution of personal information, required to enable the running of the meet.

General Information

1. Swimmers entrance will be through the main pool entrance at the front of the building.
2. Spectator tickets and programmes will be available at the table at the spectator's entrance in the Community Centre which is situated towards the rear of the pool.
3. A raffle will be held on each day of the meet. Tickets will be available in the Community Centre.
4. Car parking is available close to the pool. The nearest car park is Station Road. Payment at this car park may be made by mobile phone. At the time of writing the current cost for a day is £2.50. For up to date information about parking charges, see the Suffolk Coastal website <http://www.suffolkcoastal.gov.uk/yourdistrict/carparks/>
5. Coaches/chaperones passes are available to Coaches supporting competing swimmers. They include a Programme.
 - £12.00 for Sunday including food, £8.00 without food
 - Coaches Passes must be ordered with entries.
 - Pool Side Passes can not be bought on the day unless identity is verified by a club official and proof of CRB check is produced.
6. Awards will be available for collection as soon as possible after the publication of results for the event.
7. Results will be made available on the club website www.debenswimmingclub.co.uk as soon as possible after the meet. Alternatively, electronic results may be collected by presenting a USB memory stick to the promoter at the event.
8. Refreshments will be available for swimmers and spectators. Hot food will be available on both days, including bacon rolls in the morning and an alternative at lunch times.
9. A swim shop will be available during the meet. Facilities are available to try on costumes.
10. In accordance with the recommendations of the ASA Child Protection Policy, any person wishing to use any camera, video or digital capturing device (including mobile phones) should first register their details on the approved ASA form provided at the spectator entrance with proof of identity. An identification label will be issued which must be on show at all times. This policy will be vigorously enforced and any person found to be contravening this policy will be asked to leave the gala without refund.
11. Any conditions not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoters Deben Swimming Club and includes any alterations to the program and warm up times as necessary.
12. The safety of all competitors, officials and spectators is of paramount importance. During this event, announcements concerning your safety will be made in accordance with the recommendations of the ASA. The organisers ask everyone to pay particular
