Additional Info

For those clubs who have not been to a competition at Deben before we would like to provide some additional information. Space on poolside for swimmers and spectators is restricted and can become very crowded. We recommend that swimmers spend their time between races in the community centre next door, where the atmosphere will be much more comfortable.

1. Swimmers should store their belongings in lockers, the community centre or additional storage area. No bags should be left on poolside except during warm-ups.
2. Swimmers should bring with them clothing suitable for moving between the poolside environment and the community centre. Outdoor footwear may not be worn on poolside, so should be removed as soon as possible on entering the building.
3. Swimmers should use the main pool entrance to gain access to the building. Access will be available from 20 minutes before the start of each warm-up.
4. Spectators should go to the entrance desk in the community centre and then through the access at the rear of the pool building. This door is controlled by Deben Swimming Club staff. The rear entrance is up a few steps, but level access is possible through the front of the building. Please notify us in advance if possible if you require this facility.
5. A swimmers kitchen is available in the community centre serving hot and cold drinks, bacon rolls, jacket potatoes and other snacks.
6. A swim shop will also be located in the community centre.
7. All medals will be distributed from the community centre. Results will be posted in the spectator area on poolside, on the wall in the community centre, at the medal table and on Meet Mobile.
8. The marshalling area is at the turn end of the pool. Please keep clear of this area unless you are waiting for a race.
